Bectrol Inc. Supplier Code of Conduct – Version 2025

Introduction

At Bectrol Inc., we believe that social responsibility, ethics and sustainability are essential pillars for building strong business relationships. This code is intended for all of our suppliers, partners and subcontractors, and sets out minimum expectations for compliance, human rights, the environment, business integrity and cybersecurity.

The requirements below should be incorporated into your internal policies and business contracts. Failure to comply with this Code may result in the termination of the business relationship with Bectrol Inc.

1. Legal and Ethical Compliance

- Comply with all applicable local, national and international laws.- Avoid any form of fraud, corruption, money laundering or business manipulation.

Prohibited examples: payment of bribes, collusion during tenders, falsification of documents.

2. Working Conditions and Human Rights

- Provide a safe, inclusive and fair working environment.- Prohibit any use of child labour, forced labour or labour trafficking.- Respect freedom of association and the right to decent remuneration.

3. Health, Safety and Harassment

- Implement an OHS policy that complies with current standards.- Offer regular training on the prevention of occupational risks.- Prohibit any form of harassment, intimidation or violence.- Provide a confidential channel for internal complaints.



4. Environmental Responsibility

Measure, monitor and reduce GHG emissions and energy consumption.
 Promote recycling, sustainable waste management and the preservation of biodiversity.

5. Cybersecurity and Data Protection

Protect Bectrol Inc.'s data from loss, disclosure, or unauthorized access.
 Immediately report any information security breach.
 Comply with confidentiality and intellectual property obligations.

6. Control, Monitoring and Audit Mechanisms

 Authorizing Bectrol Inc. to verify compliance through audits or questionnaires.
 Implementing corrective actions in the event of noncompliance.
 Producing reports on ESG indicators upon request.

7. Procedure for Reporting to Bectrol Inc.

Any supplier or supplier employee who observes non-compliant or ethical behaviour must report it without delay.

Processing:- All reports are processed by the Audit Committee of Bectrol Inc.-Suppliers will be informed of the follow-up carried out.

- No form of retaliation will be tolerated against bona fide complainants. Compliance: Failure to cooperate or a proven failure may lead to the termination of the business relationship.
